

Writer's Guidelines for Occurrences

The Editor welcomes comments and articles submitted from outside sources dealing with early Washington State history. Preference will be given to those articles that deal with the Hudson's Bay Company, Fort Nisqually and other related themes. Authors will be credited; they will be responsible for the content and accuracy of their articles. The Editor may be reached by calling (253) 591-5339 or at: fortnisqually@tacomaparks.com.

Additionally:

- The Editor will review all submissions and contact authors.
- Articles should be footnoted, if applicable. Preferably in the Chicago Manual Style.
- In most instances authors are responsible for identifying and providing photos and/or illustrations, procuring permissions if necessary, and/or offering suggestions to the editor regarding suitable imagery.
- Occurrences generally publishes under the guidelines of One-time Rights (your article may or may not have been published before and you are free to use it after publication.)
- Periodically an anthology of past articles may be put together so Occurrences asks for Anthology Rights for possible inclusion of your work in these special publications.
- Occurrences accepts Simultaneous Submissions, however it is the author's responsibility to contact the Editor if the article will be appearing elsewhere before publication in Occurrences. Occurrences does accept reprints.
- Authors will receive a copy of the issue their article appears in.
