



Center at Norpoint Pool Rules

1. Children under the age of seven, less than 42 inches tall and those using flotation devices (including noodles) must be within arm's reach of an adult (18 or older) at all times.
2. A cleansing shower must be taken before entering the pool.
3. No glass containers allowed in the pool area.
4. Food, drink, gum and tobacco are prohibited in the locker rooms and in and around the pool.
5. Participants must follow the instructions of the lifeguards at all times. Persons refusing to obey rules are subject to removal from the premises.
6. Anyone in diapers must wear a protective covering to prevent contamination; diaper changing only at designated diaper changing areas.
7. Participants must be wearing an article of clothing in the pool, underwear is not proper swim attire.
8. Running, pushing, dangerous horseplay, play fighting and vulgar/abusive language are prohibited.
9. Jumping is permitted as long as participants are jumping feet first, facing the pool and not running. Spinning, flips, twists, diving, and backward jumps are not permitted.
10. Use of fins, glass dive masks and snorkels are prohibited.
11. All flotation devices must be used with adult supervision in the shallow end only.
12. Non-swimmers and weak swimmers may not use the deep end of the pool. Individuals may be required to pass a swimming test before being allowed into the deep end.
13. Use by anyone with open wounds or a communicable disease is prohibited.
14. Use by anyone who had been ill with vomiting or diarrhea within the last 2 weeks is prohibited from using the pool.
15. Anyone under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs is prohibited from the facility.
16. Anyone with a seizure, heart, or circulatory problems should swim with a buddy.
17. All emergencies should be reported to a Lifeguard or Pool manager.
18. Riding on other participant's backs or shoulders is prohibited.
19. Balls being used to play basketball must be soft to avoid risk of injury.
20. Throwing or launching people in the water is not permitted.
